

GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (GDPR) 2018

All membership organisations have a legal and moral duty to protect the data of their members. Many points in the above Regulation already apply under current data protection laws. The GDPR became enforceable on 25th May 2018 and replaced the Data Protection Act 1998 and covers the storage and use of "Personal Data".

Under the Regulation personal data is defined as any piece of personal information that can be used to identify an individual either directly or indirectly.

Hingham Rectory Bowls Club collects, stores and uses the following personal data for its members :-

Name (given and last)
Home Address including postcode
Home telephone number
Mobile telephone number
Email address

The understanding is that GDPR provides that Personal Data can be held, without the need for consent, if it is adequate/relevant/non-excessive. This means that as long as the Club reasonably considers the storage or Personal Data to be relevant and non-excessive, they can continue to hold it without the for members consent.
